How to Cook a Wife (anonymous)

Many wives are cooked on high for too long and the taste and softness may become dry. Some men may throw them out if they boil over. Be sure to remember that wives are the most tender and delicate of dishes. Do not strain, drain, or freeze. Men should take care to take wives out of the oven periodically and knead gently. Even if wives tend to become a little lumpy, they remain sweet. If treated properly, they may even be bubbly and sparkly. Men may wish to add a little flour (flower), if things get too hot. Sometimes, however, all the dish needs is a little warming and attention. Wrap securely and cover liberally with sugar (Sugar can be doubled, if desired). Wives can stay fresh for a lifetime if properly treated and generously seasoned - a little goes a long way and is good for you.
