O' For a Faith that will not Shrink

104-year-old, Laura Keeble, the wife of the late Marshall Keeble, stood beside her husband as he spent his years bringing an estimated 40,000 people to Christ and His church through baptism.

"However busy their days were, the Keebles always knelt and prayed before going to bed - and prayer is still an integral part of Sister Keeble's life. Even when she fell and fractured her back a few years ago, Sister Keeble insisted on thanking God before she sipped a cup of soup.

'She was in such pain...but she said, "Righteous Father, I most humbly thank you for these blessings that you've given me.' Cummings [her great-granddaughter] said, her voice choking with emotion.

...Sister Keeble insists on going to worship as long as she can. On a recent Sunday - even though she was suffering from a nasty cough - Sister Keeble had a relative roll her wheelchair to the nursing home lobby for the worship service. She wore a purple dress and a diamond ring that her husband gave her - a blue, decades-old church hymnal rested on her lap.

About 40 nursing home residents sang "O for a Faith That Will Not Shrink," then men from the church across the street prayed and offered communion. As the collection plate approached, Sister Keeble pulled out a \$5 bill.

'Nobody's expecting her to give,' Cummings said. But, Sister Keeble saw it differently. 'The Lord is,' she said."
