Reason 2: He Is All-Knowing

"Is it necessary to have an explanation of why God wants us to do the things asked of us? There are a zillion reasons why "Because I said so" from Almighty God is good enough. Since I can't count to a zillion, let me list five.

"Knowledge alone is a basis for "because I said so"...We are not in a position to ask God why, because our knowledge is way too limited to understand His greatness. It's like we are four. His all-knowing wisdom is so far beyond our grasp that we must accept His "because I said so" with full confidence in Him as Maker, Sustainer, and flawless Director of our lives.

"If you are not particularly tech-savvy, suppose your computer is misbehaving one morning, which probably doesn't take a lot of imagination for any of us. You call the customer service line, and after experiencing several birthdays, you talk to a knowledgeable person in the service field who begins asking questions and giving directions: Click run, type in msconfig, open this window, check this box, uncheck this box. As he talks you through a diagnosis and solution to your problem, imagine if after every direction, you ask why before obeying. Can you imagine the frustration of the technician who has a working knowledge of the computer, with the constant questioning of someone who has little understanding of a mouse cord? It seems it would quickly get to the point of, "Ma'am, this is the company that made the computer! Do it because I said so." We generally are glad to follow the instructions of a complete stranger because we understand that his knowledge in that field will greatly help us who have very little knowledge. Shouldn't the infinite and ultimate knowledge of God Almighty receive greater respect than that of a certified computer technician?"


