What is the point in establishing guardrails in your marriage? Guardrails serve the same purpose in your marriage, that they do on the road. They are to keep you safe, away from danger, right where you belong.

5 Guardrails for your Marriage

1. Don't travel alone with members of the opposite sex.
2. Don't eat alone with members of the opposite sex.
(If you find yourself in an unavoidable situation where either of these might occur, call your spouse immediately and let them know. Not only do they have a right to know, but their knowing will hold you accountable.)
3. Don't hire cute members of the opposite sex because you want to help them. Don't deceive yourself. Be smart. If they need help - let someone else help them.
4. Don't confide in or counsel members of the opposite sex. "No one understands me like you..." Like a plot in a bad movie, you already know where this is going..."
5. When you feel your heart or your desire drifting toward a specific person - tell someone. It doesn't have to be your spouse, necessarily, but it does have to be someone who will hold you accountable.
