

Diamond's are a Christian's Best Friend

I know, the song goes, "Diamonds are a girl's best friend." I realize that. However, did you know that diamonds truly are a Christian's best friend? Why, you ask? **Because diamonds prove that the earth is NOT millions of years old.** How? Let me explain.

Diamonds are believed to be formed deep underground in the upper mantle of the earth's crust. Extreme temperature and pressure form pure carbon into the diamond's crystalline form. Over time the diamond is moved upwards in the earth's crust and discovered through mining. **Science typically tells us that diamonds are millions of years old.**


