

God's truth is **absolute**. That means it is objective. It can be tested, studied, referenced.

God's truth is **attainable**. It is not out of reach. It does not exist in a language we cannot understand or grasp. It can be learned and it can set us free (Jn 8:32).

God's truth is **necessary**. It is not optional or something that we can choose to follow or not. We must know it and obey it in order to be saved (Heb 11:6; Jn 8:24; 20:30-31).

God's truth is **exclusive**. It is the only way to be saved. It is not just one of many methods of salvation, following the truth is the exclusive way to be saved (Mt 7:13, 14, 21-23; 2 Thess 1:7-9).

God's truth is **powerful**. It is not a token of a bygone generation. It can save the soul, enable one to live the best life possible here on earth, and be saved eternally in heaven (Rom 1:16, 17; Mk 10:28-30; 2 Pet 1:5-11; Phil 4:4-7; Rev 2:10).
