Thelma Ham - homebound, unable to walk any distance



"Creation: Day 7" Genesis Genesis 2:2, 3

Very few words are used to describe what happened on the 7th day of creation, in fact, I wish there were more verses describing what happened on all of the days of creation, but we simply have what we have. Though there are only two verses, there is still much we can learn. Consider...

God ceased from creating. God "ended" His work, and brought creating to completion (v. 2). The word KALAH means "to end, accomplish, cease, complete". God still works today, but He is not still "creating" new things today. For example, God is still caring for creatures and people and is at work (Jn. 5:17), but He is not creating new creatures.

God rested. Did God need rest because He was tired from the six prior days? No! God does not need rest. So then, why did He rest? It was so God could set a precedent. Ultimately, God wanted to show that He planned for man to be upon the earth and have purpose, but ultimately man's purpose would point towards something higher...being with Him. Hebrews 3:7 - 4:11 reminds us that there is an ultimate rest that awaits the faithful, and God lovingly planned it that way!

God wants us to remember Him. At creation, God selected the 7th day as a day that was notable and special. God "blessed" and "sanctified it". At creation, God seems not to have told Adam about the seventh day's special nature since Adam and others seem to know nothing of it. It was only during Moses' time on Mt. Sinai when we see God reveal His plan for Israel to recognize something God had blessed... the seventh day (Dt. 5:2, 3; Neh. 9:13, 14; Ezek. 20:10-13). Exodus 12:16 is the first mention of the seventh day and instructions were given to do no work on that day, gather no food, but to rest (Ex. 16:26, 29, 30). Though the people would have been busy gathering food (Ex. 16:26), harvesting and working (Ex. 34:21) God wanted them to be obedient, and to take time to remember Him. Though the seventh day memorial (the "Sabbath") IS something we read about Jews observing, it is NOT something we read Christians observing. Don't make the mistake of calling Sunday the "Christian Sabbath". There is no such thing spoken of in Scripture and there are too many differences to state here. However, the principle still remains that God does want us to take time to remember Him.

This week, remember that God is always at work. God points us towards a higher purpose, and that is looking forward to our rest yet to come. Therefore, let us remember Him this week in all we do!
